Two friends, two almost identical stories: Townes and Blaze wrote lyrics straight from the heart and accompanied them with beautiful guitar playing. They lived a wandering lifestyle and drifted from bar to bar. Unlike Townes, Blaze recorded very little and unfortunately a lot of material has been lost.

In September, 2008 hurricane Ike tore through the island town of Galveston, Texas. This flooded The Old Quarter

Acoustic Cafe. The owner was Townes' friend Wrecks Bell. On the walls of the cafe hung many photos and tributes

to Townes.

Fan's helped to restore the Cafe back to its original condition.

On January 1, 2009, its official re-opening, singer-songwriter Jon Hogan, a Van Zandt

and Foley admirer performed the songs "Lungs," "Dollar Bill Blues" and "Blue Ridge Mountains." Jon had performed on that same stage a few months before the
